Itinerary for our European Tour & River Cruise to Holland, France, Germany, & Switzerland

Day 1 – Arrival Day

Arrive in the Netherlands and check in to our **Amsterdam** hotel on your own. Get a good night rest as we anticipate a full day of adventure tomorrow.

Day 2 – Zaandam & Haalem, Netherlands

Embark on a memorable day in Holland, starting at a **Cheese Farm & Clog Factory**, where you can watch traditional Dutch craft making and taste homemade cheeses. Next, explore the historic **Zaanse Schans**, with its iconic windmills and charming wooden houses where we will visit a mill, a weaver's house, learn about cooperage (barrel making), clockmaking, and tour windmills. Next, we'll visit the **Corrie Ten Boom Museum** in Haarlem to learn about the brave Christian family's WWII story, and finish your day seeing the vibrant **tulip fields**, surrounded by Holland's stunning natural beauty.

Day 3 – Amsterdam, Netherlands

This morning, we say goodbye to our hotel as we spend the day exploring **Amsterdam** which offers a captivating blend of historic canals and charming architecture that paints a rich tapestry of Dutch culture and history. We'll visit a vibrantly colored **tulip market**, explore the quaint neighborhood of **Grachtengordel**, enjoy a relaxing chartered **canal boat ride**, followed by a poignant visit to the **Anne Frank House**. Later in the afternoon, we'll board our new "home away from home" just in time for a delightful dinner onboard. Tonight, following dinner, we'll have our first concert onboard! Full breakfasts, lunches, and dinners are included while onboard our river cruise! Complimentary afternoon tea, late night snacks, and 24 hr. coffee and tea is also included!

Day 4 - Dusseldorf (Muenster), Germany

Disembark from our boat in **Wesel** for our optional guided tour to **Münster**, Germany, where we'll visit the historic **St. Lambert's Church**, known for the iron cages that once held the remains of the Anabaptist leaders. We'll also stop at the **Prinzipalmarkt**, the city's medieval marketplace, to see the Münster **Town Hall**, where the infamous Anabaptist rebellion was quelled. Our visit concludes at the **Münster Cathedral**, where we can reflect on the city's Reformation church history. Our bus will then take us to **Dusseldorf**. After dinner onboard, explore Dusseldorf on your own. For those wishing to just enjoy the cruise, you'll stay onboard at Wesel and we will meet you in the afternoon when our cruise arrives in Dusseldorf.

Day 5 – Cologne, Germany

After breakfast onboard, our arrival at the beautiful cathedral city of **Cologne** will offer wonderful opportunities to explore the historic Old Town with its High Gothic architecture and the famous twin-spired **Cologne Cathedral**. Enjoy a leisurely afternoon or join us for an optional excursion as we venture farther afield to visit the charming **Drachenburg Castle**, where we'll explore its opulent interiors and enjoy panoramic views of the Rhine River. We'll venture into the **Siebengebirge National Park**, a stunning range of hills, to experience the natural beauty and serene landscapes that have inspired legends for centuries. After a wonderful day in Cologne, enjoy dinner on board as the vessel continues cruising the Rhine River.

Day 6 – Cochem, Germany

This morning our vessel takes a special trip down the romantic **Moselle River**, the largest tributary of the Rhine. This area is the 5th largest German vineyard region with some of the steepest, terraced vineyards along the river. After lunch, our vessel will arrive in **Cochem**. Explore the town, which is filled with narrow streets, twisting alleys, medieval town gates, churches and walls on your own, or discover the beauty of Cochem and visit the stunning **Reichsburg Castle** on our guided tour. After dinner on board, a special evening of gospel music is planned for us onboard our “home away from home” river cruise.

Day 7 – Koblenz & Mainz, Germany

Early this morning, arrive in **Koblenz**, ideally situated at the confluence of the Rhine and the Moselle Rivers. Join this morning's included tour exploring the town of Koblenz on foot. This afternoon, spend time on deck as we cruise the most beautiful section of the river - the legendary **Upper Middle Rhine Valley**. This area is registered on the UNESCO World Heritage list for its dramatic riverbanks dotted with vineyards and picturesque castles. Late afternoon, we arrive in **Mainz** to visit the **Gutenberg Museum** to see several of the original Bibles printed in 1455 (admission included!) *Note: The museum is under renovations. Should it not be open by sailing date, we will visit beautiful Rudesheim instead of Mainz.*

Day 8 – Mannheim & Speyer, Germany

Before breakfast, your vessel docks in the bustling town of **Mannheim** which you can explore on your own or join us for our optional excursion to nearby Heidelberg, another old university city with its beautiful **Heidelberg Castle**. This afternoon's call is at **Speyer**, a city known for its cathedral where eight Roman emperors and German kings are interred. Join us for a guided tour of one of the oldest cities in Germany and discover the secrets of the **Speyer Brezel**, one of Germany's staple snacks and famously celebrated at the annual Pretzel Festival in Speyer. At night, our floating luxury “hotel” sets sail to Strasbourg.

Day 9 – Strasbourg, France

This morning, we will arrive in the picturesque capital of Alsace. This beautiful city's sights include the famous cathedral **Straßburger Münster** and the Petite France quarter, a former mill and tanner district that still maintains its medieval charm. Half-timbered houses, the Ponts Couverts, the Palais de Rohan, and the Council of Europe are among the wonders that **Strasbourg** holds in store for you. The **Grand Island**, the city center, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is connected to the rest of the city by 22 stone bridges. We'll see Strasbourg by a beautiful **canal boat ride** on this morning's included guided excursion. After lunch on board, take in the views of the romantic Rhine as we move toward picturesque Switzerland.

Day 10 – Basel & Zurich, Switzerland

After breakfast, we say our final goodbye to our beautiful river cruise. We board our bus and start our tour in **Basel**, Switzerland. Renowned for its rich cultural heritage, the beautifully preserved Old Town with medieval architecture, the stunning **Basel Minster**, and the iconic Town Hall. Its strategic location at the borders of Switzerland, Germany, and France makes Basel a unique blend of diverse cultures and a gateway to the scenic landscapes of the Swiss countryside. In the afternoon, drive from Basel to Zurich and explore the city on a guided walking tour. **Zurich**, Switzerland's largest city, seamlessly blends modernity with tradition. Set along Lake Zurich and surrounded by the **Swiss Alps**, we'll wander through the narrow, winding streets and vibrant marketplaces, visiting historic churches like **Grossmünster** and **Fraumünster**. Here, we'll uncover the rich history of the Reformation including the carvings telling the story of the reformation and visit key **Anabaptist heritage sites**, such as the memorial at the execution site of Anabaptist leaders. Dinner and accommodations in Zurich.

Day 11 – Anabaptist Cave, Rhine Falls, Stien am Rhein

Today, embark on a full-day tour beginning with a visit to the **Lindt Home of Chocolate**, where you'll gain insight into the art of chocolate production. On the way to **Schaffhausen**, stop near Hinwil to explore the historic **Anabaptist Cave**, a significant site where early Christians sought refuge and held secret worship during times of persecution. Following our worship service there, we head to Schaffhausen to experience the awe-inspiring **Rhine Falls**, Europe's largest waterfall, renowned for its powerful flow and stunning views of the roaring waters. In the afternoon, visit the picturesque town of **Stein am Rhein**, celebrated for its well-preserved medieval architecture and charming half-timbered houses adorned with vibrant frescoes. Enjoy free time to explore some of the key attractions including the beautifully frescoed Town Hall, St. George's Abbey with its impressive cloister, and Hohenklingen Castle, offering panoramic views of the town and the Rhine River. Overnight accommodation in Zurich.

Day 12 – Bern, cheese, and Trachselwald Castle

Today, depart Zurich and head towards **Bern**, the capital of Switzerland. Your journey begins with a visit to **Kambly Cookies**, followed by a stop in the picturesque Emmental region, where you'll explore the charming town of Langnau and visit the renowned **Emmental Cheese Factory**. Continuing through the historic **Trachselwald Castle** where early Reformation Anabaptists were imprisoned for their faith. Next, we enjoy a guided walking tour of Bern, a city renowned for its stunning medieval architecture and rich history. Nestled along the Aare River, Bern's UNESCO World Heritage-listed Old Town features cobblestone streets, arcaded walkways, and iconic landmarks such as the **Zytglogge**, an ornate clock tower with an astronomical clock, the **Gothic Bern Minster**, and the **Federal Palace**, home to Switzerland's parliament. Dinner and our overnight accommodation will be in Bern.

Day 13 – Thun Castle & Interlaken

Today, we journey from Bern towards the majestic Alps, making our way to the picturesque town of Thun, situated on the shores of **Lake Thun**. Here, you can take in the stunning views of **Thun Castle**, the tranquil lake, and the surrounding mountains. In Thun, embark on a **private cruise** across Lake Thun to **Interlaken**, where you'll enjoy a delightful, included lunch onboard. This serene cruise offers an exceptional opportunity to experience the crystal-clear waters of one of Switzerland's most beautiful lakes. As you sail, you'll be treated to panoramic vistas of the majestic **Swiss Alps**, charming lakeside villages, and historic landmarks, including Thun Castle (another early Reformation prison) and **Spiez Castle**. Overnight accommodation in Interlaken.

Day 14 – Zermatt & Matterhorn

Today's journey brings us to the high mountain region and the charming village of **Zermatt**. Upon arrival in **Täsch**, you will transfer to a train that takes you to the car-free town of Zermatt, where you will have ample free time to explore at your leisure. Zermatt is celebrated for its breathtaking Alpine scenery at the base of the iconic **Matterhorn**. The village features quaint chalet-style architecture, upscale boutiques, and fine dining establishments. Notable attractions include the Gornergrat Railway, offering stunning panoramic views, the Matterhorn Museum, and the breathtaking ice sculpture museum near the top of the Matterhorn. Farewell dinner and accommodation in Interlaken.

Day 15 – Transfer to Airport

Today, we say our goodbyes as we pack our bags for home. Our buses will take you from our Interlaken hotel to Zurich airport.
